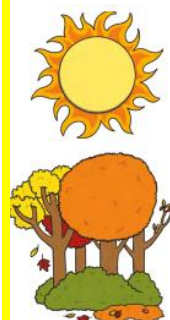
Seasonal Changes

There are changes in weather in each season.

In Spring, it is often raining and the temperature begins to get warmer.



In Summer, the sun is much stronger. The temperature is warmer than any other season.



In Autumn, the weather turns chillier, windies and there is often rain.

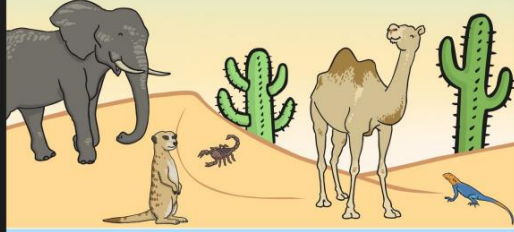
In Winter, it is often cold and frost. It has to be freezing cold to snow.

lion, tiger, meerkat, monkey, camel, scorpion, lizard, giraffe, hyena, rhino, elephant, cheetah, leopard, crocodile







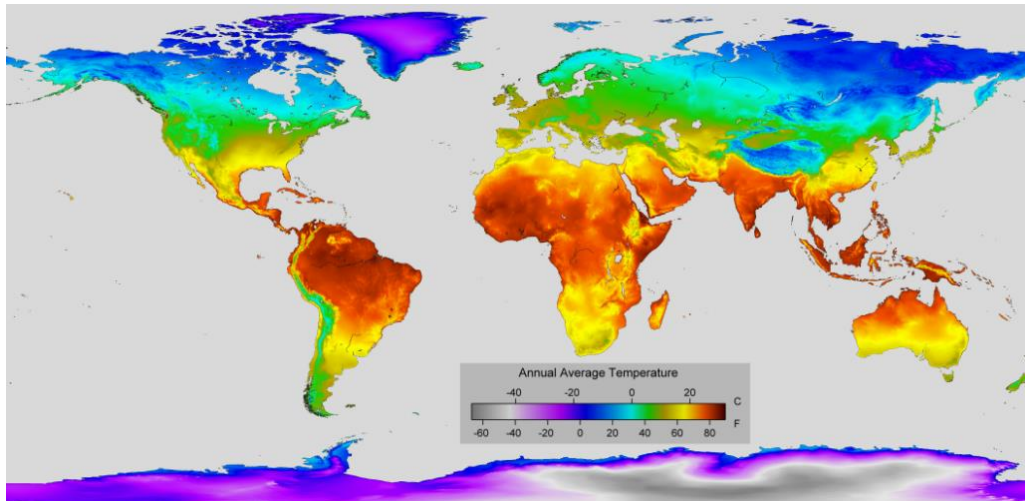
Cold Places

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Key Vocabulary

Equator 	A 'line' drawn on the Earth dividing it into the Northern and Southern hemispheres.
environment 	The surroundings or conditions of where something lives.
desert 	An empty area of land covered in sand. The weather is usually hot.
polar 	"the Polar Regions" linked to the North and South Pole.



The closer to the equator the hotter the country.
