### Artist Focus

#### Alice Kettle



Alice Kettle is a UK based textile artist. She originally trained as a painter and often begins her work with a painted background that she embroiders

The paint and stitching combine to create large areas of **colour**. She used repeated lines of stitching.

#### Hannah Rae



Hannah Rae is a textile artist from Cambridge who forms her work with embroidery. She colours fabric by printing, dyeing and painting before adding line, texture and shape through stitching.

Many of her pieces are based on the environment.

We created Christmas tree decorations using fabric and running stitches. We experimented with tints and tones of the colour green when thinking about our rainforest prints.


