This half term we are going to be focusing and developing the following areas:

- Counting to 50, ordering the numbers, comparing them, understanding one more and one less.
- Telling the time to o'clock and half past and drawing the hands on a clock
- Addition and subtraction. We will learn new methods and recap methods already learnt
- Volume and mass. We will start to investigate these practically and then learn to use them in problem solving ways and start to measure and record them

Science



This half term we will be focusing on humans. For this we will be learning to identify, name, draw and label the basic parts of the human body and say which part of the body is associated with each sense. We will also be performing simple tests and recording our data.

English

This half term we will be covering different types of writing: narrative, instructions and information texts. Throughout the half term we will be continuing to develop our understanding of what is a sentence and to use capital letters, full stops and finger spaces correctly and consistently. In handwriting we will be continuing to look at the different letter families and understanding how to form letters correctly. We will also begin Guided Reading where we will be beginning to work on understanding what has been read to us.

Geography

We will be learning to name, locate and identify the 4 UK countries and their capital cities. We will also recap our map reading skills by following them and creating our own pirate treasure maps!



Pirates
