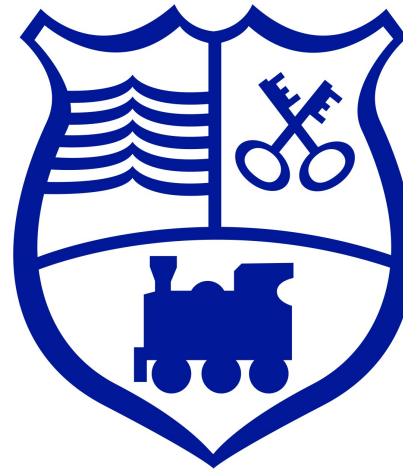
### Understanding The World
