Places to visit:

Go and visit a travel agents and collect some holiday booklets. See if you can cut and stick a collage of your favourite locations.

Outdoor Ideas:

- Make a habitat for an animal that is not native to this country.
- Pretend you are flying to a different country. Dress in the clothes you may need to wear for the climate and pack the suitcase for the trip. Go on a walk imagining you are in this new destination.

Things to make or do:

- Make a food dish from another country to share with your family.
- Try to build a famous landmark from lego or other construction toys.
- Learn how to say hello and goodbye in different languages.
- Listen to some music from a different country.

Research Ideas and Books to share:

- Visit the library and find information books on the world and various countries. Use the contents page to look up and find out about different cultures, landmarks or traditions.
- Try and make your own information book. You could number the pages and make a contents page.
- Make a scrapbook about your favourite country, using pictures, drawings and labels.
- Look at an atlas, globe or a world map. Try and spot where we live or any places you have been on holiday. Discuss how you could visit these different locations. How would you travel there?
