### Key Vocabulary

Object		A thing that can be used.
Material	★	Materials are what an object is made from.
Hard	★	Not easily broken or bent
Soft	★	If something is soft, it is easy to cut, fold or change the shape of.
Stretchy	★	Can be pulled to make it longer or wider without breaking.
Dull	★	Doesn't reflect light. Doesn't look bright or shiny.
Rough	★	If something is rough, it feels and looks uneven or bumpy.
Shiny	★	Reflects light easily
Properties	★	A characteristic to describe

Brick

We can make buildings from brick because it is very hard. It can be rough.



Plastic

We can make toys and food packaging from plastic because it is smooth and strong.

It can be hard or bendy.



Wood

We make tables, chairs and some toys from wood. It can be rough or smooth.



Paper

We can make wrapping paper and books from paper because it is smooth. It can tear easily.



Fabric

We can make clothes and bedding from fabric because it is soft.

It is usually smooth.



Glass

We can make windows, mirrors and glasses from glass because it is hard and see through.



Metal

We can make cars and spoons from metal because it is hard and smooth.

You can't see through it.
