

Wild plants	V	A wild plant seed grows where it falls. It doesn't need to be planted or cared for as it grows.	
Garden plants	1	Garden plants are plants that people choose to grow in their gardens.	
Weeds	\Rightarrow	Weeds are wild plants that grow in places where people do not want them.	
deciduous	V	A deciduous tree loses it leaves each year.	
evergreen	V	An evergreen tree keeps it green leaves all year round, even in the winter.



Roots	Roots take in water and nutrients from the soil.	
Stem	The stem holds the plant up and carries the water and nutrients from the roots to the leaves and flower.	
Leaves	Leaves catch sunlight to make energy.	
Flowers	Flowers attract insects and birds.	
Petals	Petals are the colourful part of the flower.	
Seed	Seeds grow into new plants	
Bulb	Bulbs grow into new plants.
