

Words we are going to learn


Key Vocabulary		
fish	\Rightarrow	Fish live and breathe under water. They have scaly skin, fins to help them swim and they breathe through gills.
bird	\Rightarrow	All birds have a beak, two legs, feathers and wings.
reptiles		All reptiles breathe air. They have scales on their skin.
mammals	V	Mammals are animals that breathe air, grow hair or fur and feed on their mother's milk as a baby.
amphibians	V	Amphibians live in the water as babies and on land as they grow older. They have smooth, slimy skin.
carnivore	N	Animals that mostly eat other animals (meat) are carnivores.
herbivore	V	Animals that only eat plants are herbivores.
omnivore	V	Animals that eat both plants and other animals (meat) are omnivores.
