Her use of **colour** and **tone** in the paper strips create the illusion of **texture**.



Henri Matisse

(1869 – 1954)

A French artist who was famous for his use of **colour**.

He is most known as a painter, but was also a printmaker and sculptor.

When ill health prevented him from painting in later life, he turned to cut paper collage to form the **shapes** in his work.



Key Skills

Collage is the process of finding, collecting, arranging and sticking. An artist selects the colour and texture of the materials carefully to ensure they have the desired outcome within their art.

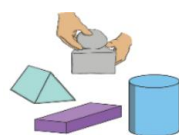

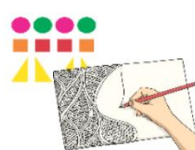

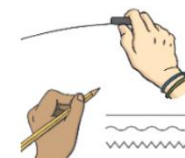
