

# Autumn Term 2 Curriculum Overview

## Year 3

### English - Writing

In writing we will be creating our own poems about emotions, looking at adding dialogue to stories and we will be writing a set of instructions for The Grinch about how to steal Christmas.

### Maths

We will finish off our Addition and Subtraction unit and then move onto Multiplication and Division.

### English - Reading

Within our new CUSP reading scheme we will be exploring the following books:

The Pebble in my Pocket  
Leon and the Place Between  
'Twas the Night before Christmas

### Science

Our science focus is:  
Rocks, Fossils and Soil.

We will look at the different properties of Rocks and how we can classify them, identify different fossils and explore what the soil around us can tell us.

### History

We will practise our skills as Historians and to explore our big question: How did change influence the Stone Age period?

### PE

During our PE lessons this half term, we will be looking at Outdoor Adventurous Activities

### Music

We will be learning to play the recorder along to Bob Marley's classic song Three Little Birds.

### Computing

We will be developing our knowledge of scratch by using loops to program and animation, a game or story.

### PSHE

In PSHE we will be looking at how we can work well as a team, play to our strengths and support each other.

### Spanish

Little Red Riding Hood  
We will learn to listen so as to understand a familiar fairy tale recounted in Spanish.

### RE
